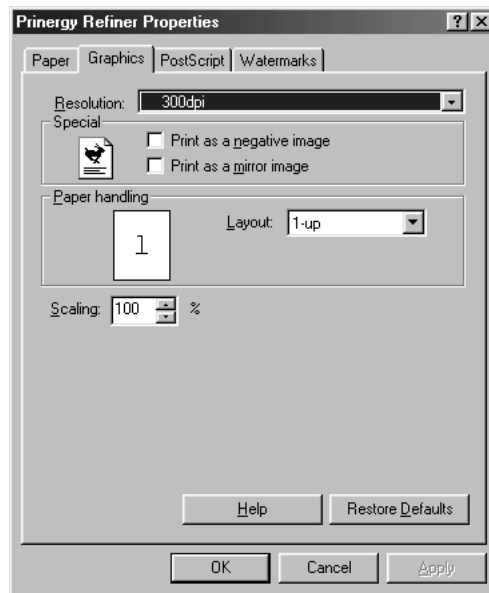
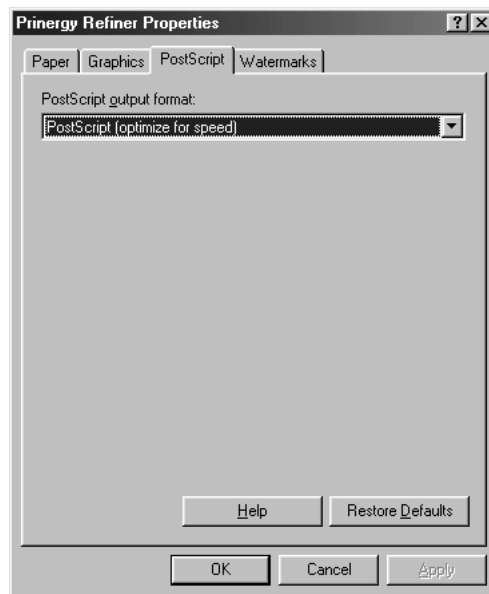


4. Click *Graphics*. Edit to match the following.

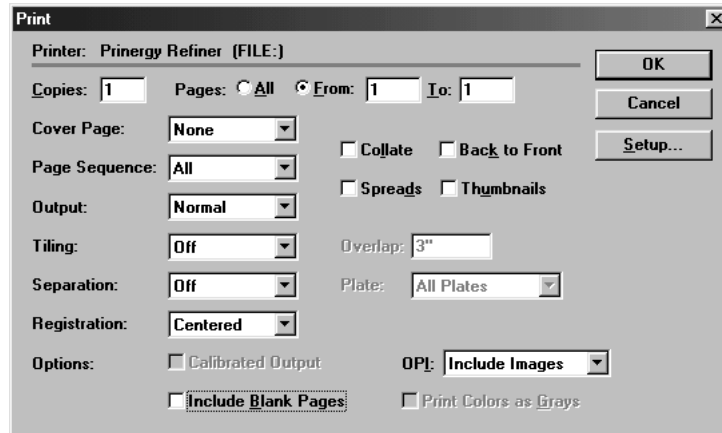


5. Click *PostScript*. Edit to match the following. Click *OK*.

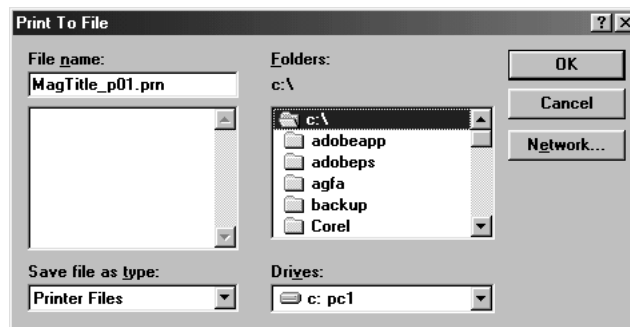


6. Click *OK* to exit the *Printer Setup* dialog box.

7. Choose *Print* from the *File* menu. In the *Pages* range, enter the page to write to PostScript. **Each page must have its own PS file.**



8. Click *OK*.



9. Name each PostScript as follows: **magazine name_page number.ps**. Pages 1-9 should be named with “spacer” zeros, i.e. p01, p02 (see example below). **Please do not use special characters such as dashes (-), slashes (/), etc. in your file name. Use alphanumeric characters and underscores (_) only.** Click the *OK* button.
