

# Adobe® PageMaker® 6.5 & 7

## Postscripting

### Before you start:

Install the Prinergy Refiner.ppd into PM65\RSRC\USENG-LISH\PPD4. Install the Adobe printer driver for your operating system into the appropriate directory. You may download copies of these files from [www.bantapublications.com/postscripting.htm](http://www.bantapublications.com/postscripting.htm).

Preflight the job and fix any problems.

[Flight Check](#), [Print Ready and Preflight Pro](#) are software applications used for preflighting, **OR** if you would rather outsource this function we recommend that you use [Magsend](#).

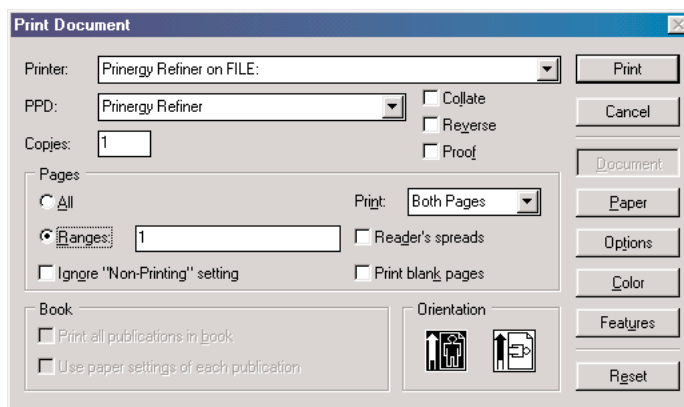
Place all page elements in the PageMaker document. Pages must be complete.

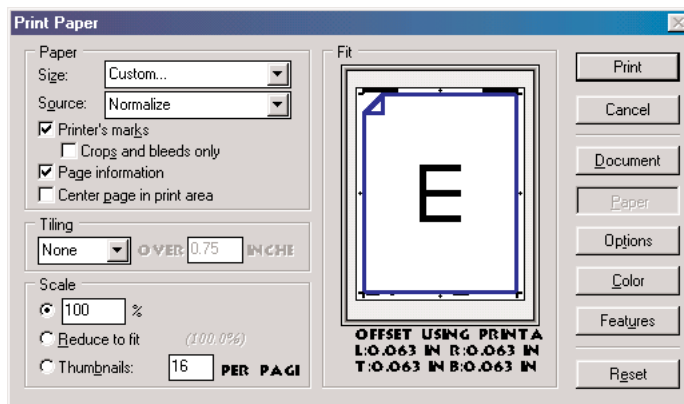
Configuring PostScript Driver

TIP: Check the *Printer's Marks* and *Page information* box first, **then** change the *Paper size*.

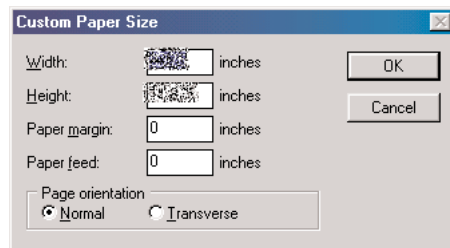
1. Before postscripting, be sure to setup a printer to save files to disk. Install the Prinergy Refiner PPD, available at [www.bpgepp.com](http://www.bpgepp.com), into PM65\RSRC\USENG-LISH\PPD4. See "Configuring PostScript Driver" instructions for your operating system.
2. Choose *Print* from the *File* menu, click the *Document* button and edit to match the following screen capture. In *Ranges*, enter the page to write to PostScript. **Each page must have its own PS file.**



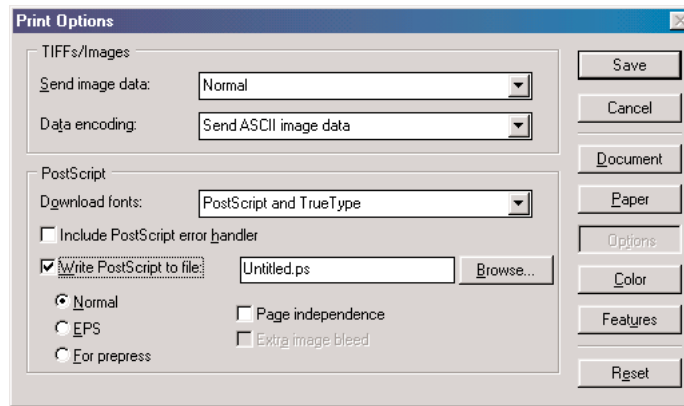
3. Click the *Paper* button and edit to match the following. **TIP: Check the *Printer's Marks* and *Page information* box first, then change the *Paper size*.**



- Immediately after choosing *Custom*, a new paper size that allows for the marks is displayed in the *Custom Paper Size* box. **The Width should be at least the Document Width + 1 1/2". The Height should be at least the Document Height + 1 1/2".** Click *OK*



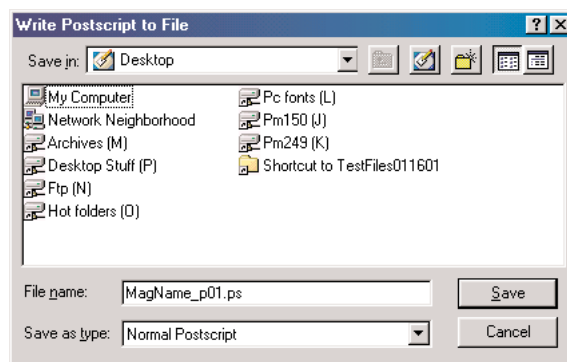
- Click the *Options* button and edit to match the following.



- Click the *Browse...* button.

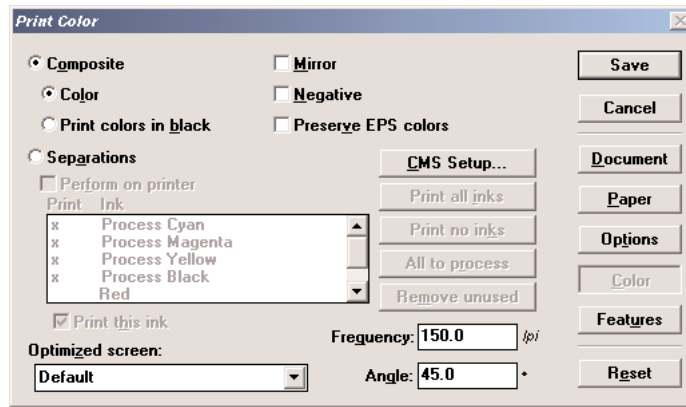
- Name each PostScript as follows: **magazine name\_page number.ps**. Pages 1-9 should be named with “spacer” zeros, i.e. p01, p02, etc. **Please do not use special characters such as dashes (-), slashes (/), etc. in your file name. Use alphanumeric characters and underscores (\_) only.**

- Click the *Save* button.

9. Select the Color button and edit to match the following.



10. Click Save in the Print dialog box to save the PostScript file.
